Greetings!

It has been a while since we have founded the Philippine Pirate Movement (PPM) in 2nd of October year 2010 and was recognized by the Pirate Parties International as the 50th Pirate Party in 20th of April year 2011. The legal registration in the Philippines was a challenge to the organization hence, there were rejections from the Philippine Securities and Exchange Commission. Finally the Philippine Pirate Movement was officially recognized by the Philippine Government last 18th of June year 2015.

During the past 6 (six) years we have established an approximate number of volunteer members of 200,000 men and women. That are organized in our Barangay (*small town*) offices of the Philippine Pirate Movement. Together with these members we were able to accomplish projects such as the following:

- Nationwide Medical and Dental Missions
- Educational Scholarships
- Natural Calamity Relief Goods and Support

Our Medical and Dental Missions started in 2011 and were able to treat different diseases of more than 1 Million people. We are still actively doing a quarterly Medical and Dental Missions but reduced to Manila City and Rizal Province due to low budget. The sponsor for this project is the Korean Missionary Doctors of the Rapha Medical Clinic.

Educational Scholarships provided a scholarship for more than 5,000 students in Computer Programming and English Proficiency courses. The project started in 2010 to 2013 and was organized together with the Keystone Cambridge College and Technical Education Development Authority of the Philippines. However, due to lack of funding and support the project ended in 2013. On the other hand, this year 2015 the Philippine Pirate Movement received a donation of 40 hectare raw land in Rizal Province. The officers and members agreed to build the largest Pirate head quarters and first Pirate University (PU). The Philippine Pirate Movement believes that its location is very strategic since Philippines is the center of Asian Countries and is accessible to all nations in the Europe and West. The Pirate University is an ongoing discussion and we would like to invite the Pirate Parties International to participate in this project. We look forward for this to be the next political and economic school where each Pirate Party will be represented and study the political and economic growth of each country and will create a strong bond amongst its students and future country leaders.

The relief goods and support mission was in September 23 – 30 2009 during the time that the Philippine Pirate Movement was still being formed by its core members. Philippines was struck by Ketsana Typhoon (*Ondoy Typhoon*) that devastated the whole country. Through the initiative of the core members and Congressman Mohammad Omar Fajardo we were able to request a 2 (two) Cargo jumbo jets of relief goods and support from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

To continue the ideologies and principles of the Pirate Parties International in the Philippines, the Philippine Pirate Movement will run in this coming May 2016 National Election in the Philippines. Philippine Pirate Movement is a political party in the Philippines that will have candidates from all over the country. We are currently choosing candidates from National to Local positions such as:

- President
- Vice President
- Senator (Upper House)
- Congress (Lower House)
- Provincial Governor
- Provincial Vice Governor
- Municipal and City Mayor
- Municipal and City Vice Mayor
- Municipal and City Councilors

We are currently filling up positions with candidates through a national selection process of the Philippine Pirate Movement based on our constitution and by-laws. We have just filled in the 3 (three) Congressional candidates for the Pirate Partylist (*Ang Tao Muna Partylist*) and a District Congressman in Province of Rizal. Province of Rizal is the largest Province near the Capital of the Philippines. We are still on the process of selection for other positions as well as the Presidential candidates.


